

Visiting Choirs

We are always delighted to welcome visiting choirs to Christ Church, and both Cathedral and city have much to offer choirs who enhance our daily worship in this way. The ancient and beautiful cathedral boasts a glorious warm acoustic, a magnificent three-manual organ by Kenneth Jones and a large and well-equipped Music Room.

The weekly pattern of services available for Visiting Choirs is as follows:

Sunday AM	Choral Eucharist at 11.00
Sunday PM	Choral Evensong at 15:30
Wednesday	Choral Evensong at 18:00
Thursday	Choral Evensong at 18:00

Rehearsal periods are from 1 hour before the service begins.

The majority of dates available for visiting choirs are during the cathedral choir vacation in July and August, though there are a limited number of dates immediately after Christmas and Easter.

It is also possible to perform a **lunchtime recital** during your visit – please contact sophie.gough@christchurch.ie for further details.

Interested choirs should contact the cathedral office as far in advance as possible. It is helpful to have a list of dates and suggested repertoire at the outset. If choirs are bringing an organist who wishes to use the cathedral organ, a CV should be submitted for approval by the cathedral Director of Music at the time of application.
