Joseph Beech is the Sub-Organist of Durham Cathedral, where he is the choir's principal accompanist, playing the organ for daily services, broadcasts, concerts, recordings and tours. He also assists the Master of the Choristers in his work conducting the choir, and recruiting and training the choristers. Joseph is a prize-winning graduate of the Royal Academy of Music, where he studied with David Titterington, and where he was elected to Associateship in 2022. He previously held organ scholarships at St George's Chapel, Windsor Castle; Brompton Oratory, London; St Paul's Cathedral, London; and was later Assistant Master of the Music at St Mary's Cathedral, Edinburgh.
