Taking up the organ as a chorister in Kent, James went on to read Music at Exeter College, Oxford, where he held the Parry Wood Organ Scholarship and directed the Chapel Choir. Earning a First, he spent two years in Florence as Organist and Choirmaster at the English Church. James has twice appeared as a finalist at the Northern Ireland International Organ Competition and was delighted to return last summer to assist competitors at the console. James is a Fellow of the Royal College of Organists.
